Dear Parent/Carer

Year 11 students have recently completed an in-class assessment on An Inspector Calls; a text we study for the English Literature paper two. Students had a choice between two questions; character or theme. This was a 50 minute assessment, worth 30 marks, with the purpose being to prepare for the paper in both the mock and summer exam.

Students have received their mark, grade and targets for improvement in class. Please could we encourage you to discuss this with your child.

The results of this assessment have provided students with an understanding of their current working grade; allowing them to identify areas for revision. Every student has been given a consolidation booklet to complete as ongoing revision. This will be checked fortnightly by their class teacher. The booklet contains key quotations for all literature texts and revision activities.

Year 11 students will have formal mock exams during the week commencing Monday 4 November. The mock exams will be English Literature paper two (An Inspector Calls, Power and Conflict poetry, and unseen poetry) and English Language paper one (Explorations in creative reading and writing).
