They will also need to bring a packed lunch and snacks - a hot drink in a flask would also be beneficial. **Please be aware that we have students who may be participating in this trip who have a serious nut allergy. Please avoid giving your son/daughter bagged nuts or products with a nut content, as even the smell can cause these students anxiety.**

If the weather is severe for Baslow on the day, the walk will be postponed for safety reasons.
