### **Mock Examinations**

As we move towards the summer term all of our Year 11 students will be taking their second session of mock exams. The exams will run from Friday 3 March-Tuesday 7 March (Maths and English) and 27 March to Monday 3 April 2017 for all other subjects. For each main exam there will be pre-exam focus time. This will take place with their subject teacher.

Students will sit an exam for each GCSE subject they are taking, together with some BTEC subjects. Each subject will be allocated a separate time so that all students taking that subject sit the exam together. A subject timetable has been issued which is also available to view on the website.

There will be a few students who have clashes due to their subject choices. These students have been given a separate timetable with details of what to do so that they can sit their missed exam. Any students who are absent for mock exams will be expected to go to the main exam room upon their return to arrange to sit any missed exams.

All students need to be in school for 8.45am. Timetabled lessons will take place during the mock exam period when students are not in exams. Some students taking afternoon exams may be later leaving school, due to the length of the exam.

If your child has access arrangements, these will be provided as usual.
