

## Psychology Parent Advice:

Psychology has a lot of content for students to remember. If you want to help your son or daughter to revise for their psychology exams, here are some tips to help you:

- Access psychology past papers on the AQA website and look for past papers and mark schemes. Unit 1 exam papers will test them on modules they learned in Year 10 and Unit 2 in Year 11. Mark schemes are also available for each paper.
- Students have information booklets for their units. You can use this to test them on the course content, asking questions like, “What is the method for a study on deindividuation?” You don’t need to be an expert, just use the resources and test them!
- Encourage your son or daughter to complete revision regularly. Allow them to stick post it notes around the house with key information.
- There are Apps set up for revision. Look for revision Apps that include the AQA course. Gojimo is a good one!
