Venn diagram - Compare & Contrast

Analysis x6 (unless otherwise stated by the teacher) 2 of which can be in a visual form (picture & labelled with key words)

You should be taking a **MINIMUM** of 1 **photo-shoot** per fortnight (2weeks).

This photo-shoot should then be annotated (20 - 30 frames) & **best images** edited.

You should be doing a minimum of 1 hour / week **homework**.

(You have 5 hours of class time & 2 hours h.w = 7 hours total per 2 weeks in which to do this)

Deadline for final outcomes mounted and completion of all prep work is your last lesson before the Christmas holidays.

‘how to annotate in photography’ - when annotating your photoshoots - Sentence structures & key words

‘Selection of images from photoshoot’ - HELP WITH ORGANISATION or for those who are aiming high to help develop & move forward
